

2007-Present Toyota Tundra Airbag Brackets - With LRT Lift (SKU# LR-FAB)

Installation Instructions





CAUTION: Safety glasses should be worn at all times when working with vehicles and related tools and equipment.



Suggested Tools:

- 9/16 socket and ratchet.
- 9/16 box end wrench
- Foot-Pound Torque Wrench








Note

These brackets can be installed either before or after the Firestone Ride Rite Air Bags have been installed. To keep things simple we made these instructions for installing the brackets on the lower air bag mount before the air bag kit was installed on the vehicle.



Step 1

Obtain the Lower air bag mount from the Firestone Ride Rite Air Bags Kit.



Step 2

Align the holes in the bracket with the holes in the lower air bag mount as shown.



Step 3

Install the (4) bolts and washers supplied with the bracket.



Step 4

Install the washers and nuts as shown.





Step 5

Using a 9/16 box end wrench, hold the bolt. Then snug the nuts using a 9/16 socket and ratchet. Finish tightening the nuts by torquing them to 33 ft. lbs.




Step 7

These brackets can also be installed after the air bags have been installed. If needed, the instructions for the air bags are supplied with the Firestone Ride Rite Helper Springs/Air Bag Kit. This product can be seen/purchased on our web site by clicking HERE.

Step 6

Repeat steps 1 through 5 on the second air bag support to be used on the other side of the vehicle.



Caution:

These brackets are designed to fit firmly against the axle housing. If they do not, you will need to unbolt them, turn them around (180•) and reinstall them.
